

HOW TO PAY YOUR ENTRY FEE

Please note that our legal name is *Tour d'Afrique Limited*, and this must be used as the beneficiary name on all wire transfers.

YOUR INVOICE

Your tour invoice shows your exact entry fee with any additional charges and/or discounts applied. You will be notified by email when your invoice is ready, and it will also be available in your MyTours dashboard. If you are ready to pay and have not yet received your invoice, please [let us know](#).

PAYMENT CURRENCIES

Each of our tours is priced in either US Dollars (\$) or Euros (€), and this will be the currency used on your invoice. However, you may pay your entry fee in any of the following currencies:

- Canadian Dollars (\$)
- US Dollars (\$)
- Euros (€)
- British Pounds (£)
- South African Rand (R)

If you are paying in the same currency used on your invoice, go to the corresponding page below (USD \$ or EUR €) for payment instructions.

CURRENCY CONVERSION

If you would like to pay in one of the other currencies mentioned above, you must first convert your payment amount:

1. Locate the total amount owing on your invoice (invoices are available on myTours close to the payment deadline). [Please email us if you have not received it.](#)
2. Go to xe.com and enter the amount owing as shown on your invoice. The currency of your invoice (either USD \$ or EUR €) should be selected in the 'From' box, and the currency in which you would like to pay should be selected in the 'To' box.
3. Click 'Convert', and you will see the amount to be sent in your preferred currency. Note – this rate will fluctuate from day to day. Please check the converted amount **on the day you are paying and not before**.
4. Go to the page below corresponding to the currency you will be paying in for further instructions.

note – this is a ZAR (R) currency account at a bank in South Africa and only meant for receiving South African Rand and no other currency.

FURTHER NOTES AND TIPS ON SENDING MONEY

Registration fee - Please note that the US\$150 registration fee which you pay when signing up for one of our tours is in addition to and is not part of your entry fee. (Payment of the registration fee secures your place on the tour.)

Remitly, OFX, and Wise are a few of the popular online money transfer services that can save you transfer costs. This is especially true for clients whose home currency is not one we accept transfers in. These services often give you a better exchange rate than your bank will, and their transfer fees are typically lower than most banks.

Cheques must be payable to “TDA Global Cycling” or to “Tour d’Afrique Limited”. We only accept personal cheques in USD (\$) or CAD (\$) and no other currencies. We do accept official bank cheques in US Dollars, Canadian Dollars, Euros and British Pounds.

Credit card payment - We typically do NOT accept payments by credit card due to the high costs involved. If you must use a credit card, please contact our office, and we will discuss the best option with you. All credit card payments will have a 4% fee added to cover the transaction costs.

Problems sending international transfers - The info banks require to send transfers to Canada can differ from place to place. If your bank advises that our account details are either incorrect or incomplete, try resolving this by incorporating some or all of the following in your transfer information:

- Try combining our transit / branch number and our account number: e.g. 17042-7320338 (USD account example)
- Some countries require a 9 digit transit number for the Canadian bank they are sending funds to. This number is 000417042 (= leading zero + 3 digit Canadian Banking Institution # + 5 digit transit / branch #).
- TD Canada Trust Bank may appear in some online platforms as The Toronto-Dominion Bank at 55 King Street West in Toronto. This is also an acceptable address - it is the main Toronto headquarters of TD Canada Trust.

Mistakes - Any mistakes in transfers may result in a loss of about 5% of the transfer value. TDA will unfortunately then have to ask you to resolve the lost amount as we expect to receive your payment in full. For this reason, please enter the bank wire transfer information carefully and reach out to us if you have questions.

Bank fees - Please also note that you are responsible for paying the fees your bank charges you to send the transfer to our bank (and we are responsible for the charges our bank charges us).
